## HIGH COURT OF BOMBAY AT GOA, PORVORIM

Applications are invited from eligible and physically fit candidates for the preparation of a Select List of 1 candidate for the post of Driver (Staff Car) on the establishment of the High Court of Bombay at Goa as per the provisions of "The High Court of Bombay at Goa Officers and Members of the Staff on the Establishment (Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 2023 and Guidelines framed thereof, , in Matrix Level 2 (₹19900 - ₹63200) of the 7<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission & other allowances as admissible under the Rules.

### A. ELIGIBILITY:

- i) Candidate must have passed at least S.S.C Examination or must have passed equivalent examination.
- ii) Candidate must be able to speak Marathi & Hindi languages.
- iii) | Candidate must have knowledge of Konkani.
- years of age and not be more than 45 years of age in case of General category. The maximum age limit shall not be applicable to the High Court/Government Employees. Further, the age limit shall be relaxed by five years [i.e upto 50 years of age] in case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes / Scheduled Tribes and by three years [i.e. upto 48 years of age] for Other Backward Classes.
- v) Candidate must have a valid and effective driving license having one year validity as on the date of publication of this advertisement. Candidate must possess driving license as per Motor Vehicle Act 1988 (Sec 59/1988). Such driving license must have been validly issued by the competent authority and must be functional in respect of light motor vehicle.
- vi) Candidate must have not less than 3 years experience of driving motor vehicles such as cars and/or heavy vehicles on the date of publication of the advertisement.
- vii) Candidate must have a clean record of driving and no criminal/civil proceedings/case should be pending against him and he should not have been punished by any Court of Law.
- viii) Candidate must be competent enough to sign any contract lawfully and should not be disqualified for the post under any law.

- ix) Candidate must have basic working knowledge of maintenance and ordinary repairs of the motor vehicles.
- **x)** Candidate must have knowledge of the topography and roads in Goa.
- **xi)** Candidate must be physically fit and free from vices and should bear a good moral character.

## **B. INFORMATION ABOUT THE VARIOUS TESTS:**

- i) Shortlisted candidates shall first be required to appear for the written examination/screening test of 20 marks of 40 minutes duration comprising of multiple-choice questions based on the following subjects:
  - a. Traffic Rules, Vehicle maintenance and knowledge of basic repairs (07 marks).
  - b. Knowledge of topography of State of Goa (07 marks).
  - c. General Knowledge (06 marks).
- ii) Only those candidates who are successful in the written examination/screening test, shall be called for the driving test (to be taken by RTO) of 10 marks and only those who pass/succeed in the driving test, shall be called for the oral interview/viva voce of 10 marks.

# C. INSTRUCTIONS:

- i) The candidates will have to appear for the written examination/screening test, motor vehicle driving test (practical) and *viva voce* as and when called for, at their own expense, on the date, time and place as may be informed by the Office of the High Court of Bombay at Goa, Porvorim on the official website or as may be intimated *vide* e-mail.
- **ii)** Details/instructions regarding Admit Card shall be uploaded on the Official website of the High Court of Bombay at Goa Or forwarded to the candidates by e-mail or registered post.
- **iii)** Verification of documents & testimonials with the Originals shall be done at the time of *viva voce*/Oral Interview. Only eligible candidates will be allowed to appear for *viva voce*/Oral Interview.
- iv) The schedule of recruitment process is subject to change on account of any unforeseen event/s beyond the control of the High Court of Bombay at Goa. Such change would be published on the Official website of the High Court of Bombay at Goa from time to time.

- v) Candidates shall have no right to claim participation in the process, if the number of posts are varied or the selection process is cancelled for any reason whatsoever beyond the control of this Office.
- vi) The High Court of Bombay at Goa reserves all rights to alter the process of examination, to suspend the examination or to cancel or to partially alter the process of the examination.
- vii) The candidate shall declare in the Declaration Form appended to the Form of Application as to whether there is any criminal prosecution pending against the candidate or whether the candidate has been held guilty or convicted by a Criminal Court or is facing disciplinary/criminal inquiry.
- viii) The candidate must not have more than 2 living children as stated in the Declaration as per Form A appended to the Application Form. In case a candidate has more than 2 children and has a child born after 28.03.2006, such candidate shall not be considered for the post.

**Explanation:**-For the purpose of this clause, where a couple has only one child, any number of children born out of a single subsequent delivery shall be deemed to be one child. Provided that, a person having more than two children on 28.03.2005, shall not be disqualified for appointment under this clause so long as the number of children he/she has, does not increase after 28.03.2006.

Provided further that a child or more than one child born in a single delivery within the period of one year from 28.03.2005 shall not be taken into consideration for the purpose of disqualification mentioned in this clause.

- x) At the time of the examination candidates must carry their driving license as per condition A(v).
- **xi)** While filling in the name, the spelling of the name should be as per the documents pertaining to the Educational qualifications or as per the proof of change of name or marriage certificate.
- **xii)** Candidates are required to submit their full residential address along with landmark and the Pin Code and shall not give vague or incomplete address.
- xiii) Candidates shall furnish their email and mobile number in use.

- **xiv)** Candidates are required to write the date of birth as per the Educational document / Birth Certificate.
- xv) Candidates are required to furnish necessary details of their children as per Declaration in Form 'A'. If a candidate does not have any children, then he is required to insert "Zero" (0) / "Not Applicable" in the respective column.

# D. SHORT LISTING:

- i) High Court of Bombay at Goa reserves the right of shortlisting the candidates on the basis of higher educational qualification and academic excellence. High Court of Bombay at Goa also reserves the right of of shortlisting the candidates at the stage of screening test and practical test.
- ii) The eligibility of the candidates shall be finally decided after scrutiny of the applications.
- iii) The list of eligible candidates shall be notified on the website of the High Court of Bombay at Goa.

# E. SELECT LIST:

- i) The Select List of candidates shall be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in the written examination, motor vehicle driving test (practicals), the candidates past experience and the oral interview/viva voce.
- on the basis of performance of the candidates in the tests, a Select List of candidates shall be prepared, in the order of merit and the same will be published on the Official website of the High Court of Bombay at Goa, after the selection process is over in every respect.
- **iii)** The appointment to the above said post shall initially be on probation for a period of two years. During the period of probation and until certificate about satisfactory completion of probation period is issued, the services of the appointee shall be liable to be terminated at any time without any notice and without assigning any reason.
- iv) The name of the candidate shall be removed from the Select List without any notice, if it is revealed that any information furnished by such candidate in the Application Form is incorrect/false/wrong/misleading or if the candidate has concealed material facts.
- v) If a candidate on the Select List fails to join duties within the period stipulated in the letter of appointment, the name of the candidate will be deleted from the Select List, unless the Honourable the Chief Justice is satisfied that failure was due to unavoidable reasons and beyond the control of the candidate.

## F. MANNER OF SUBMITTING THE APPLICATION FORM:

- i) The candidates should send the application only in the prescribed format which may be downloaded, printed and duly filled in by the applicant by blue ink only and in own handwriting with latest three passport size colour photographs, of which one photograph should be affixed on the application. It should be duly signed across in such a manner that part of the signature should come on the photograph and the remaining portion on the application form.
- Applications should be addressed to the "Registrar (Administration), High Court of Bombay at Goa, Porvorim -Goa- 403 525 and be sent only by R.P.A.D. or Speed Post in a sealed envelope, duly superscribed with the words "Application for the post of Driver (Staff Car)" so as to reach this office by 5.30 p.m. on or before 24.09.2024. The candidates should note that, applications received thereafter or sent by any other mode such as Ordinary Post, Courier service or by Hand Delivery will not be accepted.
- Those working in the Government Offices shall apply through proper channel by R.P.A.D./Speed Post only i.e., the application should be routed through Head of Department by obtaining No Objection Certificate.

# G. PROCEDURE FOR PAYING APPLICATION FEES:

- i) Candidates are required to deposit ₹500/- using the "e-challan" facility. The said deposit shall be non-refundable.
  - ii) Candidates shall not be entitled to be called for the written examination/Driving

    Test or *viva voce* only because they have submitted applications and paid the fee

    as per the above requirements for the post.
- iii) Candidates are directed to follow the instructions given in the User Manual for "e-challan" available on the official website of this Hon'ble Court.
- **iv)** Only those applications received along with valid 'e-challan' receipt of online payment shall be considered for the selection process.
- v) In case of any difficulty arising while depositing / paying the fees with the facility of "e-challan", this Office shall not be responsible and no complaints shall be entertained in this regard.
